ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14(1)

Notice of Temporary Traffic Order
Alvescot to Kencot-B4477
Prohibition of Through Traffic and Waiting
Date of Order: 5 June 2023
Coming into force: 12 June 2023

This Order is being introduced because of Topographical, GPR and Drainage Survey works which are anticipated to be completed on 24 June 2023, working 8pm to 6 am.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle proceeding or waiting in the length of the B4477 (Carterton to Filkins road) between Alvescot and Kencot and the unnamed road from the B4477 junction to the B4020 junction (Alvescot triangle).

Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for police, fire and ambulance services and for the works and for access to premises which are only accessible from the closed section of road.

The alternative route for traffic will be signed via Filkins, Burford and Carterton and vice versa.

This Order will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
